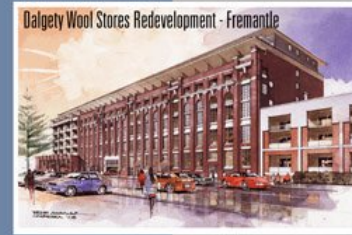

the Maylands Development - Corner of 8th Avenue & Whatley Crescent.

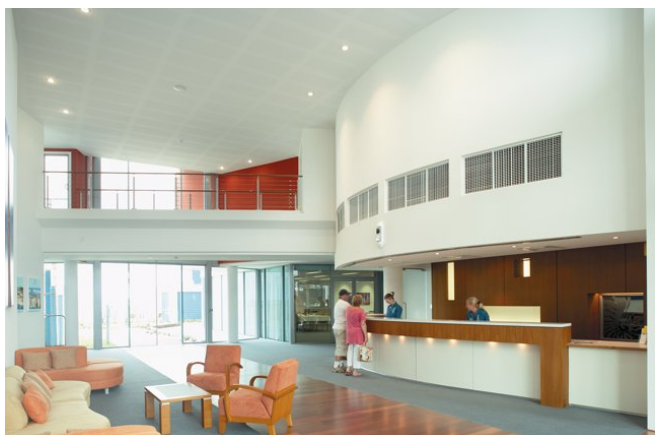
